

WHO SHOULD I CALL?



911

- Medical emergency
- Public safety concerns
- You need emergency medical services, fire, or police



988

- Mental health emergency
- You're having suicidal thoughts
- You need help with a substance use crisis
- You want to talk to a crisis counselor

- Poison emergency or questions
- If you suspect a poisoning or overdose
- Medication questions



Provide as much information about the emergency as possible;

- Where you are:
 - Street and house number;
 - Access routes.
 - Describe your location if you do not know exactly where you are.

Further information about the emergency situation may be requested.

Trained staff will guide you through the conversation and clarify the following questions:

- What exactly happened?
- How many people are affected?
- What injuries or damage is there?

Do not hang up unless the emergency staff tells you to do so. Wait for further questions.

In a case when first aid is needed, the emergency staff will offer instructions to you and inform you how to provide support to the injured person until emergency services arrive.
