

5 Common Poison Mistakes



Product Misuse

Using cleaning wipes on the skin can cause burns and skin irritation.



Vomiting

We never want someone to vomit after swallowing too much medicine or something that can hurt them. After vomiting the product may get in lungs or burn the throat when it comes back up.



Product Storage

Do not store cleaning items with things that you eat. This can lead to mix-ups and accidental poisoning.



Mixing Cleaning Products

Mixing products can make harmful fumes that can cause watery eyes, coughing or difficulty breathing. Never mix 2 cleaning products together or **bleach** with **vinegar**, **ammonia** or **rubbing alcohol**.



Medicine Storage

Child Safety Caps are not "child-proof". These will only slow down a child. Store all medicine and vitamins up high and out of sight.
