## OPIOID MEDICATION


A Risk for Children and Teens

How often are children and teens exposed to opioid medication?

Each year, opioid medication poisoning causes more than 300 deaths in children and teens.

Every 45 minutes, poison control centers get a call about children and teens exposed to opioid medication





About 1 in 10 of these cases are admitted to a health care facility

What ages of children and Teens are most at risk?

Young children (ages 5 and younger) Account for 60% of these calls

**60%** 



Most cases (86%) are unintentional, like when a child finds pills that are in reach

**Teenagers** (ages 13 through 19) Account for 30% of these calls

**30%** 



Most cases (72%) are intentional, like when a teen takes their parents' medication

96% of these poisonings happen at home
