

Reduce the Chance of Pesticide Poisoning

Keep these common household pesticides out of children's reach:

- Bath and kitchen disinfectants and sanitizers, including bleach.
- Products used to kill mold or mildew.
- Roach sprays and baits.
- Insect repellents.
- Rat and other rodent poisons.
- Weed killers.
- Flea and tick shampoos, powders and dips for pets.
- Swimming pool chemicals.

How do you know if your child has been poisoned?

The signs of pesticide poisoning may look like the flu. If your child shows any of the following signs after coming in contact with a pesticide, call **Wisconsin Poison Center** right away.

- Headaches
- Dizziness
- Muscle twitching
- Weakness
- Tingling
