Mr. Yuk is a safety tool used to educate children about poison prevention and to raise awareness of poison centers. It helps kids learn to avoid dangerous items.

Put the Mr. Yuk sticker on items that could be harmful and explain that anything with the sticker should not be eaten, smelled or touched.

Reasons to Call

- **Contact with a harmful item (on accident or on purpose)**

Did you or your child eat, touch, breathe in something that could be toxic? Unsure what to do next? Call the Poison Center to quickly speak with someone who can help. Calling the Poison Center right away could save you a trip to the emergency room.

- **General Information**

Do you need advice or have questions about a plant, medicine, bite or sting, or product? Give us a call.

Most Things Can Be Poisonous When Used:

- **In the wrong way**
- **In the wrong amount**
- **By the wrong person**

This can include plants, chemicals and medicine.

Who Answers the Phone

The Wisconsin Poison Center is staffed by nurses, pharmacists and physicians who have special training on poisons and what they do to the body. They will answer your call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to help.

What to Know Before Calling

Be ready to share the following when you call:

- Your phone number
- Your ZIP code
- Date of birth of person who came in contact with a poison
- Weight (if known)
- Name of the item they came in contact with. Have the product or container near you during the call if possible.
- How much of the item or product was involved

All questions about poisons are smart questions. **Ask FIRST to prevent poisoning!**
